From the October 31st meeting:

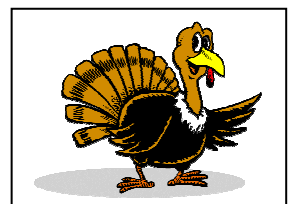
1. Flint Rotary’s Vince O’Keeffe dazzled the luncheon group as he played his soprano sax.
